

## SATURDAY GENERAL RULES

- ❖ All boys and Co-ED teams should report to the church of St. Mary and St. Athanasius located at:  
**1245 Eglinton Avenue West, Mississauga, Ontario, L5V 2M4**  
by 8:30 AM for a review of the rules.
- ❖ All Girls teams should report to the church of Daniel and the three saintly youth located at  
**6341 Mississauga Road, Mississauga, Ontario, L5N 1A5**  
by 9:30 AM for a review of the rules.
- ❖ The day leaders and/or the referees and/or the scorekeepers are entitled to temporary/permanently suspend one or more players from a game/tournament due to non-Christian behavior and/or verbal/physical harassment including but not limited to swearing, fighting, mocking, etc.
- ❖ The day leaders/referees are entitled to modify tournaments as they see fit in accordance with the day schedule.
- ❖ Duration of the games are pre-determined under the rules of the tournaments for each sport respectively.
- ❖ Soccer, Basketball and Volleyball tournaments start with group stage followed by knockout stage.
- ❖ Table tennis and Chess tournaments are knockout style.
- ❖ A team is considered to have lost the game by forfeit if they are more than 2 minutes late than the scheduled start time of any game.
- ❖ If a team shows up with insufficient number of players to a sport (less than the specified number), they will play with less players with the opponent team having the right to play full team if present. (
- ❖ Co-ed teams must have 2 girls or 2 boys playing at all times in order to qualify to play in the Co-ED tournament. Failure to meet this requirement will result in your

team playing with less players with the opponent team having the right to play full team if present.

- ❖ Food will be provided in specific times (Check the General Saturday Schedule for these timings)
- ❖ Schedules of all five sports will be available using TV screens and/or Charts located on the floor plan image for Saturday.
- ❖ A player/servant shall not discuss with a referee regarding any of his/her decisions.
- ❖ The schedules for Chess and Table Tennis are designed to fit within all three group sports. You should by no means accept to play chess or table tennis when your team is scheduled to play soccer, basketball or volleyball. Please talk to the day leaders (Mario Haroon / David Saweris /Michael Wadie) if you have any concern.
- ❖ In PCC, there are lockers that we are allowed to use but remember to bring your OWN locks.
- ❖ Please remember, MIX is hosted within the arms of the Church, so you should act accordingly.
